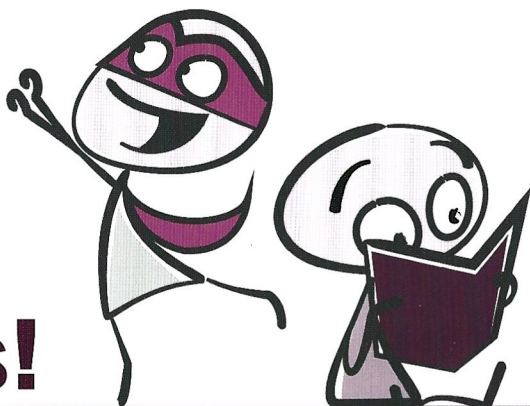


Babies and Children Love Books!
